Dear Parents/Carers,

Enrichment Week 2018 - Year 8, 16th- 20th July 2018

We are again planning to enhance enrichment provision at Bishop's by having a week of Enrichment Activities at the end of the Summer Term. On the Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of the week pupils will engage in a range of exciting learning activities and on the Thursday (if they are not on the Battlefields trip) they will have a fun day out with their Head of Year and Form Tutors to celebrate the end of the academic year.

We are also providing Alternative Activities at no cost on each day should pupils and parents prefer. These activities will take place in school and will be timetabled across Years 7 to 10; the nature of the Alternative Activities will be determined when we have exact numbers. Enrichment Activities and Alternative Activities can be chosen on a mix and match basis.

There is also the opportunity for your daughter to take part in a two day visit to the World War One Battlefields in France and Belgium on Wednesday 18th July and Thursday 19th July; see attached information for full details.

A summary of the week's activities for Year 8 is attached together with the cost of each activity. Further information together with specific details for each day will be issued much nearer the time.

In order to be considered for a place on the residential trip, a non-refundable deposit is required by Monday 4th December 2017. The balance of the residential trip is payable in 3 instalments by February 21st, March 21st and April 21st 2018. Alternatively the total cost of the trip can be paid in full by Monday 5th December.

The cost of the daily activities and outings will be confirmed by the Finance Manager in January. **Payment is required by February 21st 2018.**

All payments should please be made via WisePay.

If your daughter is in receipt of free school meals some of your costs will be met by the school. For families not in receipt of free school meals but experiencing financial difficulties, please contact Ms. Nickson as some assistance may be given on a case by case basis. In the event that a trip is over-subscribed, students with good levels of attendance and without negative behaviour points will be prioritised and entered in to a draw for places.
