Dear Parents/Carers

Year 7 Residential Visit – Bushcraft, Hatfield Woods near Hertford Monday 15th - Wednesday 17th July 2019

As part of Discovery Week, Year 7 pupils have the opportunity to take part in a three day residential course taking place at the Hatfield Woods, Brickendon, near Hertford. This will be run by the Bushcraft Company (<http://www.thebushcraftcompany.com/>) who we had very successful stays with for the past three summers.

There will be lots of practical activities such as cutting tools, orienteering, fire building and cooking. The overnight accommodation will be in tents and all dietary requirements will be catered for.

On Monday 15th July 2018 girls will register before departing by coach from Bishop's at 9am. Departure from the camp will be on Wednesday 17th July 2018 at 2:30pm and we will aim to be back at school at approximately 3:00pm.

As well as the Bushcraft staff, there will be Bishop's staff on site overnight, who are familiar with the girls.

The total cost of this visit will be **£185**. This will cover all food, activities and accommodation in tents.

Please note there are limited places available. **In order to be considered for a place on this residential trip, a non-refundable deposit of £50 is required by Monday 3rd December 2018.** The balance of the residential trip is payable in 3 instalments by February 21st, March 21st and April 21st 2019. Alternatively, the total cost of the trip can be paid in full by Monday 3rd December.

- i) A £50 initial deposit by 4th December 2018
- ii) A further £45 by 21st February 2019
- iii) A further £45 by 21st March 2019
- iv) The remaining £45 to be paid by 21st April 2019

Bishop's Hatfield Girls' School Terms and Conditions for Residential Trips

Participation in residential trips is dependent on:

- Pupil of attendance of above 95% unless the absence is authorised by the school;
- An outstanding level of behaviour.

In the unlikely event that your daughter is unable to go on the trip due to illness, or any other insured event, supporting evidence will need to be submitted to the school Finance Office so that an insurance claim can be made.

If an amount for cancellation/amendment is charged by the Travel Company, this will be deducted from any refund paid.

If your daughter **chooses to withdraw** from the trip for any other reason, a refund will only be possible if another pupil is able to take her place.

In the instance where a trip with limited spaces is oversubscribed a ballot for places will take place and be supervised by a member of the leadership team.

Failure to adhere to the payment schedule may result in your daughter being withdrawn from the trip.
