Year 10 Residential Visit PGL Sunday 14th July - Wednesday 17th July 2019

As part of Discovery Week, we are organising a 4 day / 3 night visit to Liddington Activity Centre run by PGL. This will take place from Sunday 14th July to Wednesday 17th July 2019.

This trip will give pupils a truly unique opportunity to participate in a range of activities including abseiling, raft building, orienteering, following a tree top trail and riding zip wires. This learning complements the content and skills taught for GCSE and A-level Science and Mathematics.

The cost of this trip is estimated to be **£300.** This will cover all travel and 3 nights' accommodation in at a PGL run hostel, meals and insurance for the duration of the trip.

The final cost has not been confirmed and may rise or fall depending on the number of participants and final choice of activities we choose to participate in.

Please note there are limited places available. In order to be considered for a place on this residential trip, a non-refundable deposit of £75 is required by Monday 3rd December 2018. The balance of the residential trip is payable in 3 instalments by February 21st, March 21st and April 21st 2019. Alternatively, the total cost of the trip can be paid in full by Monday 4th December.

- ii) A further £75 by 21st February 2019
- iii) A further £75 by 21st March 2019
- iv) The remaining £75 to be paid by 21st April 2019

Participation in residential trips is dependent on:

- Pupil of attendance of above 95% unless the absence is authorised by the school;
- An outstanding level of behaviour.
