Dear Parents/Carers,

Discovery Week 2019 - Year 7, 15th - 19th July 2019

We are planning to enhance enrichment provision at Bishop's by having a week of engaging trips and activities at the end of the Summer Term. "Discovery Week" will give your daughter the opportunity to discover more about herself, the curriculum and the world around her. On the Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of the week pupils will engage in a range of exciting learning activities and on the Thursday they will have a fun day out with their Head of Year to celebrate the end of the academic year.

There is also an opportunity for your daughter to take part in a three day Bushcraft residential course at Hatfield Woods near Hertford on Monday 15th until Wednesday 18th July. See attached information for full details.

On every day there is a selection of activities for your daughter to choose from. A summary of the week's activities for Year 7 is attached together with the cost of each activity. Further information together with specific details for each day will be issued much nearer the time.

In order to be considered for a place on the residential trip, a non-refundable deposit of £50 is required by Monday 3rd December 2018. The balance of the residential trip is payable in 3 instalments by February 21st, March 21st and April 21st 2019. Alternatively, the total cost of the trip can be paid in full by Monday 3rd December 2018.

We will write to you in January to confirm your daughter's choice of trips and activities and the total amount payable. Full payment for day trips and activities is required by February 21st 2019.

All payments should please be made via WisePay.

If your daughter is in receipt of free school meals some of your costs will be met by the school. The amount of financial support will be confirmed by the Finance Manager in January. For families not in receipt of free school meals but experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the Headteachers as some assistance may be given on a case by case basis. In the event that a trip is over-subscribed, pupils with good levels of attendance and without negative behaviour points will be prioritised and entered in to a draw for places.
