Year 7 Science Trip to The Royal Air Force Museum on 10th May 2019

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of your daughter's Science course we are organising a day visit to The Royal Air Force Museum on Friday May 10th 2019. We shall travel by coach, leaving school at 9.00am and returning at 3.00pm approximately. Your daughter should wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch.

There are only a limited number of places available for this trip. Only those pupils for whom we have received parent/carer permission by the deadline of **Friday 3rd May 2019** will be considered for a place. If pupil numbers exceed the number of places available, then a ballot will be held. Those unsuccessful in the ballot will receive a full refund and be given priority in the next school visit available to them.

The cost of this trip is **£14** and includes a unique interactive *Science and Aviation* workshop in addition to the exciting exhibitions that will be visited. Payment of this amount is voluntary, but the reality is that unless sufficient voluntary contributions are made to cover costs we will be forced to cancel the trip for all pupils. Please make payment, via Wisepay by **Friday 3rd May 2019**. 50% of the cost of the trip will automatically be met by the school for pupils in receipt of free school meals.

All pupils not attending will complete subject linked work in school on that day.

In order to fulfil the staff:pupil ratio recommended by The RAF Museum, we may require some parent voluntary helpers. If you are willing to help in this way, please can you contact Mr Krendel by Friday 3rd May 2019.

Normally, girls should not use mobile phones on school trips. If there are particular reasons why parents wish their daughters to be able to use them, these must be put in writing to Mr Krendel in good time for him to respond. While it is not always possible to guarantee the time of return of trips, parents should arrange for their daughters to be collected at the time given.
