Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope your daughter is looking forward to the Year 7 Discovery Week trip to LEGOLAND Windsor on Thursday 18th July 2019. This is an excellent opportunity to discover how Lego is used to build model cities as well as working models and to enjoy the thrills of the park's rides\*. **The coach will leave school at 8.30am promptly.** We hope to return to school by 6.00pm. Please understand that it is not always possible to guarantee the return time due to traffic conditions; we will put travel updates on the BHGS Facebook page.

We advise the girls to wear comfortable clothes, appropriate for outdoor activities, as well as comfortable walking shoes. A light raincoat might also be advisable, depending on the weather and if your daughter would like to go on water rides! Sun protection is also advisable if we are lucky enough to have good weather. As food in the park is usually quite expensive, we recommend that the girls bring a packed lunch and a bottle of water. A packed lunch will be provided for girls on free school meals.

Girls may wish to take some pocket money on the trip to buy water or ice cream as well as souvenirs. Normally, the girls should not use mobile phones on school trips. However, if there are particular reasons why parents/carers wish their daughter to have her phone at Legoland, she may bring it. Please bear in mind that all of your daughter's possessions, including money and mobile phone, will be her responsibility. If your daughter is required to take any medication during the day of the trip then she must bring it with her and hand it to a member of staff, apart from inhalers and emergency allergy medicines, such as Epipens, which must be carried by the girls themselves around the park.

We are looking forward to an enjoyable day out to celebrate your daughter's successful first year at BHGS.
