## Dear Parents/Carers

I am very pleased to be able to explain to you the arrangements for the Year 10 trip as part of Discovery Week 2019.

On Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July, we have arranged a day trip to Thorpe Park. We will depart from school at 8:45 am so your daughter will need to arrive in school by 8:30 am. We will leave Thorpe Park at 4:30 pm and aim to be back at school at around 5:30 pm, depending on traffic. We will be travelling by coach.

- Food and drink: The girls should bring a packed lunch with them, or sufficient money to buy food at Thorpe Park. They should bring plenty of water. A packed lunch will be provided for girls on free school meals.
- Spending money: The girls should bring money for a locker, and may want spending money for snacks, drinks and amusements.
- Mobile phones/cameras: It would be a good idea for girls to bring their mobile phone so
  they can update you on what time they will be home. However, please remember that all
  valuables/belongings are the responsibility of the girls, and the school will not accept any
  responsibility for loss or damage to them. A waterproof bag may be helpful for keeping
  phones and valuables dry on the rides.
- Clothing: Girls should wear casual, comfortable clothing and shoes, and they should be prepared to get wet on some of the rides. It might be a hot day and they will be outside for the majority of the time, so I would strongly advise that they bring plenty of sun-cream.

If your daughter is required to take any medication during the day of the trip then she must bring it with her and hand it to a member of staff.

We hope that this will be a very enjoyable day for all the girls.
