At this stage in the year we encourage all Year 12 students to research their choices for Post 18, including applications for Higher Education.

For some students, the type of courses and experience offered by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge are an appropriate choice to be considered. Competition for places at Oxford and Cambridge is fierce and the application process, which differs significantly from that for other universities, often seems daunting.
