## Year 11 Theatre Trip to see 'An Inspector Calls' - Wednesday 18th March 2020

As part of your daughter's GCSE English Literature course we have been able to secure 50 tickets to see an acclaimed performance of Priestley's An Inspector Calls, which is a key GCSE Literature text for GCSE exams in May 2020. Seeing the play will provide an invaluable opportunity to recap the action and main themes presented in this play. It is a matinee performance at 2.30pm at Cambridge Arts Theatre in the centre of Cambridge. We will travel by coach, leaving school at approximately 12.15 and returning after the performance at around 6.15pm depending on traffic. Your daughter must wear full school uniform for this trip. Lunch will be early and will need to be a packed lunch that will be eaten at school before we leave for Cambridge. Those girls who are FSM will be provided with a school packed lunch.

The cost of this event will be £40. Payment of this amount is voluntary, but the reality is that unless sufficient voluntary contributions are made to cover costs we will be forced to cancel the event for all pupils. Please make payment, via WisePay, by Friday 11th October 2019. 50% of the cost of the trip will automatically be met by the school for pupils in receipt of free school meals.

There are 50 spaces for this trip. Only those pupils for whom we have received parent/carer permission by the deadline of Friday 11th October will be considered for a place. If pupil numbers exceed the number of places available then a ballot will be held. Those unsuccessful in the ballot will receive a full refund and be given priority in the next school visit available to them. All pupils not attending will attend lessons as normal on that day.
