Westminster Abbey - A Level Trip, Friday 22nd November 2019

To support your daughter/son in their study of History, I have arranged a visit to Westminster Abbey in London to take part in one of their educational sessions and a tour on Friday 22nd November 2019. This session is targeted at students who are studying the Tudors breadth study at A Level.

During the session students discover what sovereignty meant to Elizabeth I as they stand at the Coronation site and find out how her religious settlement affected Westminster Abbey. I am confident that this will be a fantastic opportunity for them to engage with the topic and develop their understanding further.

The cost of the session and tour is **£8**. In addition, students will be expected to pay for their own return train travel expenses. I will arrange with the students to meet me at Hatfield Station at 8.15am. The event will finish at approximately 1.30pm and we will get the train back as soon as we can. I am happy for students to choose to stay in London after the workshop as long as they have written permission from you on the day.

Please note that there are limited places available. If pupil numbers exceed the number of places available, then a ballot will be held. If you would like your daughter to accompany us on this visit, please make payment via WisePay by **Friday 11th October 2019**. 50% of the cost of the trip will automatically be met by the school for pupils in receipt of free school meals. Payment of this amount is voluntary, but the reality is that <u>unless sufficient voluntary contributions are made to cover costs</u>, the trip will not take place.
