Dear Parents and Carers,

2020 is the 60th anniversary of the opening of Bishop's Hatfield Girls' School. We are excited to offer all pupils in Years 7 to 10 the exciting opportunity to celebrate this special occasion as well as the end of the academic year with a whole school trip on Thursday 16th July 2020.

We will travel to London to see a matinee performance of the new musical '*& Juliet*' at the Shaftesbury Theatre. The show asks 'what if Juliet's famous ending was really just her beginning? What if she decided to choose her own fate?'. The story is a sensational journey of self-discovery and second chances, told through glittering pop anthems including Baby One More Time, Since U Been Gone, Roar, Love Me Like You Do and Can't Feel My Face.

The cost of the trip is £31, which includes the cost of the ticket and transport. 50% of the cost of the trip will automatically be met by the school for pupils in receipt of free school meals. If your daughter is eligible for pupil premium and you would like to discuss the payments, please contact the school to discuss the available options.

To secure a place on the trip please pay at least **£15 by Friday 28th February 2020 with the remaining balance to be paid by Friday 22nd May 2020**. The trip can be paid for via Wise Pay.

Your daughter will need a packed lunch or money for lunch from the canteen as she would on a normal school day. We will be eating lunch at school before the journey to London.

Further details will follow closer to the day. Please be aware that the trip will involve a later start time and a return to school at around 6.30-7pm. Please make appropriate arrangements regarding your daughter's journey to and from home.
