Hampton Court - A Level Trip, Friday 22nd May 2020

To support your daughter/son in their study of History, I have arranged a visit to Hampton Court in London to take part in one of their educational sessions and a tour on Friday 22nd May 2020. This session is targeted at students who are studying the Tudors breadth study at A Level.

During the session, students will analyse Henry's own personal faith, the rollercoaster of shifting dogma and factions and the people who held different sway over the King's action. Through study of both the physical evidence of Henry's palace and contemporary documentary sources, students will evaluate the factors that would set the course of England for centuries to come.

The cost of the session and tour is **£20**. We will be travelling to Hampton Court by minibus and will be leaving at 8.35am and returning to school at approximately 3.00pm. Your son/daughter will need to bring water and a packed lunch.

Please note that there are limited places available. If pupil numbers exceed the number of places available, then a ballot will be held. If you would like your daughter to accompany us on this visit, please make payment via WisePay by **Friday 19th March 2020**. 50% of the cost of the trip will automatically be met by the school for pupils in receipt of 16-19 Bursary. Payment of this amount is voluntary, but the reality is that unless sufficient voluntary contributions are made to cover costs, the trip will not take place.
