Dear Parents/Carers,

Due to Covid precautions we are not able to run our usual 'Meet the Personal Tutor and Sixth Form Information Evening' which was scheduled for the evening of Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020. First of all, the evening is usually an opportunity for you to meet the Personal Tutor that has been allocated to your daughter. The Personal Tutor system is run in the Sixth Form so that we can offer the most effective personalised and individual support for your daughter across the two years. Instead of meeting the tutor at the evening on 10<sup>th</sup>, your daughter's Personal Tutor will email you directly to introduce themselves. They will also give you the opportunity to arrange a one-to-one phone conversation if you would find this helpful. Your daughter's tutor can answer any questions or queries you may have about school life, address any concerns you have about your daughter's progress, or pass on information to the school if there is anything you think we should know.

The cancelled evening is normally also a chance for you to listen to a presentation on the procedures and systems that are in place in the Sixth Form, and to find out more about the many opportunities available for enrichment and personal development.
