Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 10 Geography Fieldtrip 5th-6th May 2022

In order that pupils gain the necessary range of skills to sit Paper 3: Geographical Applications of the GCSE Geography course, we are organising a two-day field trip to Sheringham, Norfolk. During this enjoyable trip pupils will be practising the data collection and analysis skills required for this examination. Paper 3 contributes up to 30% of marks which is a significant proportion of the overall GCSE grade. The visit is also an enjoyable time to visit and investigate the coast, which is also an important topic we study. Transport will be by coach and accommodation will be in the Sheringham Youth Hostel with all meals provided, apart from lunch on the first day.

Students will need to arrive at BHGS by 7.45am on Thursday 5th May 2020 so that we can leave promptly at 8am. We plan to arrive back at BHGS approximately 4.00 p.m. on Friday 6th May, depending on traffic conditions. While it is not always possible to guarantee the time of return of trips, parents should arrange for collection at the time given.

The total cost of the trip will be **£85** per student, which covers all transport and driver costs, tuition, food, insurance, equipment, course costs and accommodation. Please pay a non-refundable deposit of £45 by Monday 28th March by WisePay. The balance of £40 is payable by Wednesday 20th April. 50% of the cost of this trip will automatically be met for pupils in receipt of free school meals.

Further practical details about clothing etc will be sent out nearer the time.

Thank you for your support and if you have any queries about the trip then please do not hesitate to contact me. I appreciate that pupils have not been on residential school visits for a long time, so please do let me know if you have any additional information you think we should be aware of.
