## Year 8 Trip to Legoland, Tuesday 3rd May 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very pleased to offer a combined Maths and Computing trip to **Legoland Windsor** on **Tuesday 3rd May 2022**. Pupils will partake in two workshops. The first workshop is Lego SPIKE Prime where pupils work together as they complete a series of mat-based challenges using LEGO® Education SPIKE Prime robots. The second workshop is Lego, Camera, Actions where pupils utilise unique Stop Motion software to collaborate and create their very own LEGO Movie. Pupils will also be offered an opportunity to explore the resort in order to experience the rides and attractions.

These workshops are perfect for teachers and students to experience a fun, hands-on and engaging session hosted by trained educational staff. All of the workshops utilise the world's finest educational play materials: LEGO® bricks and cover key curriculum targets including English, Computing and STEM.

We will be travelling by coach to Legoland Windsor, leaving school at **08.35am** and returning at approximately **17:30pm**. **Please note that this is 2 hours and 30 minutes after the end of school.** Pupils should wear full school uniform and bring a waterproof coat. Your child will need a packed lunch and you may wish to provide a small amount of pocket money for a souvenir from the gift shop.

The cost of this trip is **£30.00**. Payment of this amount is voluntary, but the reality is that unless sufficient voluntary contributions are made to cover costs, the trip will not take place. Please make payment via WisePay by **Wednesday 27th April 2022**. 50% of the cost of the trip will automatically be met by the school for pupils in receipt of free school meals.

**There are 50 spaces for this trip.** Only those pupils for whom we have received parent/carer permission by the deadline of Wednesday 27th April 2022 will be considered for a place. If pupil numbers exceed the number of places available, then a ballot will be held. Those unsuccessful in the ballot will receive a full refund and be given priority in the next school visit available to them. If we do not receive payment by Wednesday 27th April 2022, we will assume that you do not wish your daughter to attend. All pupils not attending will attend lessons as normal on that day.
