Examination Results

Dear Parents and Carers,

Results days for Years 11 and 13 are returning to their normal format, with A level results being released on 18th August, and GCSE results on 25th August. To ensure that our students receive their results promptly and have the best possible support available to them we will be releasing results via email and additionally in person. All students will receive their results via email, results will be emailed to student school email addresses. Students also have the option to attend school and receive results in paper.

A Level and BTEC Level 3 results will be emailed home to students from 8:00am On Thursday 18th August, they will also be available to collect from school between the hours of 8am and 10am. During this time students will also be able to attend school and receive support from teachers in relation to making changes to university applications, gaining guidance in relation to results and having the opportunity to celebrate with their peers.

GCSE and BTEC Level 2 results will be emailed home to students from 8.00am on Thursday 25th August, they will be available to collect from school between the hours of 10.00am-12.00noon During this time students will also be able to attend school and receive support from teachers in relation to making changes to Sixth Form course choices, gaining guidance in relation to results and also having the opportunity to celebrate with their peers and teachers.

We understand that not all students will feel a need to attend on results day, however the option is available to them should they wish to come into school and this is often a lovely opportunity to celebrate with friends, teachers and families. We understand that some students will need extra guidance and support and will ensure all students who need to speak with a member of staff have the opportunity to do so. This is particularly important for Year 13 students who may need to reevaluate their university choices and Year 11 students who may need to make adjustments to their Sixth Form course selections.

If a student would like a family member to collect paper results on their behalf they must communicate with the school in advance via email (exams@bishophatfield.herts.sch.uk) or writing, outlining who will be collecting their results for them. The named person must then arrive on results day with a copy of the letter or email as well as photo identification.

Finally we would like to take this opportunity to praise students for their maturity, dedication and commitment to achieving the very best during the exam period. We look forward to celebrating their success with them and you.
