End of term Jubilee Summer Fête

Afternoon of Thursday 21st July

I am writing to let you know about our exciting summer celebration of friendship and the Jubilee, which will be held in the school afternoon of Thursday 21st July.

This will take the form of a traditional village fête, with a wide variety of games and activities. Forms will work as teams to design and run stalls and games for each other, helping them to develop some of our core values of teamwork, trust and kindness whilst also having a fun and enjoyable afternoon celebrating with their friends and staff.

Pupils are welcome to come to school in clothes with a red, white and blue theme, or cultural dress celebrating their heritage in recognition of diversity in the UK over the past 70 years. We hope to provide each pupil with an ice cream / lolly during the fete. If the tidying up goes according to plan, we will also allow pupils home from approximately 2.45pm onwards. The school will remain open and the coach will run as normal for those needing to stay until normal time.

In order to make the stalls and games a success we need to cover the cost of prizes and some basic equipment. Please would you pay £3 via Wisepay, which is open now, to help cover these costs. This will mean that forms will have a little more freedom to design and choose games which are creative and even more enjoyable. Pupils entitled to the Pupil Premium will have the £3 covered by the school. Pupils will be issued with tickets that they can then use to choose which games they would like to do during the afternoon.

We are very keen to make this event as fun as possible as it is lovely to finally be able to hold a whole school activity. We hope that all pupils will very much enjoy this opportunity, and welcome any support you can offer.
