

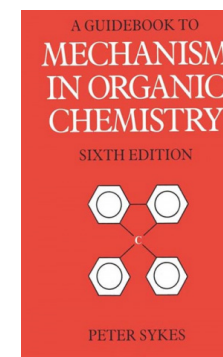
Year 12 & 13 Chemistry resources

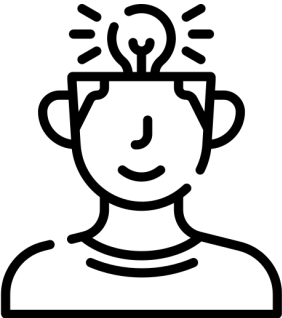
