


The Bishop's 360 illustrates the purpose of our curriculum, what we hope our pupils will learn and the journey we want them to take. It demonstrates our commitment to developing the whole person, taking a 360 degree view of education.

These are the 3 elements of developing skills.
Between them they lead to pupils having the tools to flourish

Our **values** are at the core of the 360 - they provide a reference point and a guide to how we behave and to the decisions we make. They inform how we develop the 3 facets of our curriculum: knowledge, skills and character. The values are not exclusive: we recognise that there are other values that may also play a role in how we behave.



These are the 3 elements of developing character.
Between them they lead to pupils leading more fulfilled lives, both within and beyond school.

These 3 facets are interdependent: to have any one without the others renders it less meaningful. Each facet is segmented to aid our thinking and provide clarity.

These are the 3 purposes of developing knowledge.
Between them they lead to powerful knowledge, rooted in subject curricula and the expertise inherent in those who teach them.
