Exam Results – Year 11

- 89.81 % 9-4 grades (67.89% national average)
- 40.96 % grades were 9-7 (21.6% national average)

23 students achieved grades 7-9 in a minimum of 8 subjects

Average attainment (5.6) was 0.6 grade above the national (4.8)



Exam Results – Sixth Form

- Year 13 A Level pass rate of 100% with:
 - 59.6% (52.72*) of grades at A*, A or B
 - 31.4 % (26.63*) of grades at A*/A.
