Sociology in Action - Monday 13th November 2023, Central London.

Sociology in action is an outstanding day for enthusiastic Sociology students where they can experience university lecture-style talks from leading sociologists, academics and media personalities. They will address a range of challenging and powerful questions on how society functions, the factors which influence our choices and how we experience life. Presenting a unique opportunity for students to immerse themselves in today's big sociological issues, this day will take students beyond their classroom experience, and leave them buzzing with new ideas and fresh perspectives. Topics covered will include race, education, feminism, gender, crime and deviance and the media.

There will be five talks throughout the day, starting at 10.45am and ending at 15.45pm, students will need to bring a packed lunch/snacks. We will travel by train where students will be expected to meet their teacher at Hatfield train station at a time confirmed nearer to the date. Our estimated time of return back to Hatfield station will be 16.45-17.00pm. Students will be dismissed from Hatfield station around this time.

Please also note that there are only 20 spaces for this trip. Only those pupils for whom we have received payment from by the 16th October will be considered for a place. If pupil numbers exceed the number of places available, then a ballot will be held. Those unsuccessful in the ballot will receive a full refund. All pupils not attending will attend lessons as normal on that day.
