Once your child has attended 2 trial lessons, they will receive a certificate that details how to sign up for weekly lessons.

The Get Playing offer includes:

- Free trial lesson
- 20% discount on Spring term lessons 2024
- Free instrument loan for the Spring term (normally £28 per term for any instrument)
- Free membership of 1 HMS ensemble starting in the Summer term (normally £59 per term)

Weekly lessons are available to book starting after February half term – book early to secure your place!

There are different lesson types available with HMS – individual, shared or small group lessons. The options your school can accommodate are detailed and available to book in the sign-up process.

- 20 minute individual lessons £16.00 per lesson
- 30 minute individual lessons £24.00 per lesson
- 30 minute shared lessons £12.24 per lesson
- 30 minute group lessons (3-6 pupils) £8.16 per lesson
