Year 8: Work Shadowing Monday 29th April 2024

The Year 8 work shadowing day is an extremely important opportunity for your child to spend a day out of school visiting a workplace of your choice to shadow a member of staff to understand a little more about the working environment and the employability skills used day to day.

Our pupils very much enjoy this day and as this is a cornerstone of our careers education in Year 8, all of the pupils are expected to take part. This day will support work covered in Life Skills on the nature of work and the importance of developing transferable skills for employment. We have worked closely with a number of large local employers in recent years who are always impressed that our pupils have taken up this opportunity in Year 8. This day also helps the pupils to recognise the skills they develop in school and how such skills apply in a workplace environment.

I appreciate your support in finding a workplace for your child to visit for the day.

The shadowing day can be in any working environment you choose and feel comfortable with for your child.
