

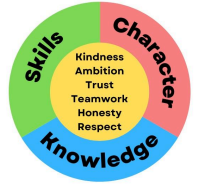

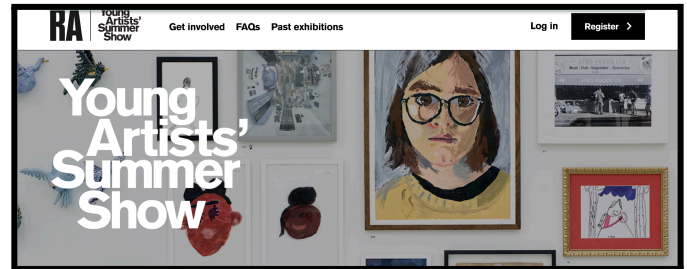
Dear parents/carers,

Year 7 only

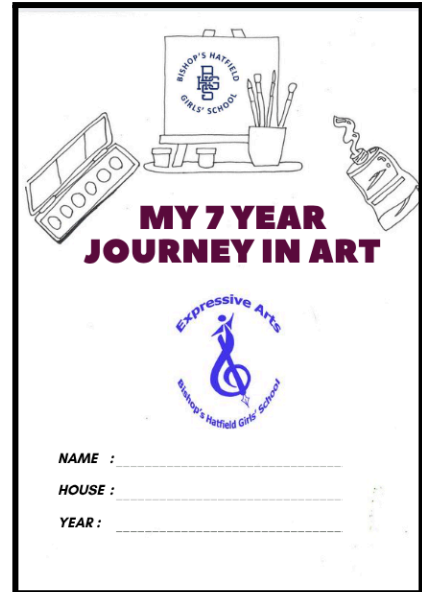
